What a busy week we have had at school. Here are some of the things we have learnt about over this last week for you to discuss at home:

- We continued learning about our topic on maps. We explored a range of maps and continued a chosen map using various drawing tools and labels.
- As part of our Under the Ocean topic we read "Billy's Bucket" we re-told the story by creating a text map. We then used this to act out the story.
- We are beginning to use some describing words (adjectives) in our writing. We described the creatures that Billy found in his bucket.
- We wrote our own text maps to re-tell the story.
- We created some lovely observational drawing of shells and fish and used a variety of resources to make ocean animals
- In maths, we learnt about Number bonds to 10. We are so good at adding two and even three numbers together
- We started learning about odd and even numbers and doubles
- In RE, we continued to learn about Palm Sunday.
- We got to perform in our wonderful Lent Concert.
- In PE we continued our topic on ball skills.
- In PSHE we discussed how to help ourselves go to sleep and understand why sleep is good for us
- We are impressing our teachers with our Phonics knowledge. We are becoming such good, independent readers
