#### It has been a busy week!

**Sentence Writing Practice** -For some children, extra practice at writing a simple sentence would benefit them. A picture will be sent home in their handwriting book. Please keep the handwriting book in their bags so that we can see how your child is getting on with this.

Handwriting (letter formation) Practice -We have noticed that some children are still writing their lower-case letters incorrectly. It may be one or two letters or quite a few. Additional handwriting practice will be sent home as needed. This will be in their handwriting books and/or on handwriting sheets. For some children, they may also need extra practice in class. Please do check that your child is forming the letters correctly as they practise at home. Correct letter formation supports writing ability and stamina and helps as they progress onto cursive writing in Year 2.

Glue Sticks - we are running very low again. If you are willing and able to donate any glue sticks, we would be very grateful.
