Things to try at home

We would appreciate it if your child could continue practicing getting themselves dressed and undressed at home. Taking their jumpers on and off would be particularly helpful, as would practising rolling up jumper sleeves (for water play and washing hands etc).

We have been focusing on recognising our names; reinforcing this at home, (showing them what their names look like) would be wonderful!

Notes for parents

- Monday, the 23rd September, the school photographer will be in the school to take individual and sibling photos.
- Please ensure you sign 'The home time arrangement form' to let us know who will/ may pick your child up at home time.

- The children have all been allocated to a 'house' or school team. We will display these
 on our classroom doors for you to see.
- A reminder that children are not permitted to bring in toys from home.
- Naming uniform It is wonderful that so many of you have been able to purchase
 uniform from the second-hand shop. Please do ensure however that you do rename
 these items with your own child's name. Please also ensure that new uniform is named
 with both Christian and surnames as we have some children with the same Christian
 name.
- Naming shoes- please ensure your child's shoes are also named.
- Don't forget long hair needs to be tied up.
- Please remember a healthy afternoon snack for you child. These can go in their book bags.
- Our topic is 'Peek into the past' and would be grateful if your child could bring in a photo of themselves as a baby or toddler by Monday.
- We would also apricate any recycling and junk modelling to use in our creation station.
- Next week your children will be learning the sounds m,a,d and s. Here the sounds we will be learning with your children, it will be useful to practise these with them at home.
