What another busy week we have had. Here are some of the things that we have covered at school for you to discuss at home:

- We have continued our topic on "People who help us" by focusing on learning about Police officers. We became detectives for the week, using our police skills to solve a problem.....Our class Bears disappeared overnight.
- As part of being a detective we made Wanted posters to put up around the school looking for our class bears. We hope we find them soon!
- We are continuing to enjoy reading to each other in Phonics and to an adult too. Your child might tell you that they have moved to a different group or have a new Phonics teacher.
- In RE we shared the story of "Jesus welcoming the children". We learnt that Jesus Welcomes everyone and that we are all special to him
- In RSE we read a story that discussed saying sorry when we make a
 mistake and asking for forgiveness. We talked about how feelings can
 affect actions, and that actions have consequences
- In Maths we explored finding different representations of the numbers 6, 7 and 8. We also looked at 1 more than a given number
- In Funky Fingers, we continued to develop our fine motor skills by drawing, colouring, cutting and manipulating playdough.
- In PE we are impressing Mrs Ramsden with our Gymnastics skills
- In Games we are continuing to learn how to control a ball, throwing and catching and bouncing it to each other.
