

## Our Week



Can you believe that we have now been at school for a whole half term? It has been a wonderful start to our school journey. Below are some of the things we have done this week. Your child might like to tell you a little more about a few of these:

- We went on an Autumn walk and drew and labelled pictures of all of the signs of Autumn that we found. Here is a song we have been learning https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8xXvVvAFEQQ
- We read the story "The Enormous Turnip" and discussed what happened in the story. We used actions to re-tell the story. Can you ask your children to see the actions?
- We also used pictures to re-tell the story and we challenged ourselves by having a go at writing the characters from the story.
- In R.E we talked about how God made the world and each one of us and how we must look after ourselves and each other
- In Phonics we learnt the letters and sounds sh, th, ch and z. We are trying so hard to blend letters to read simple words (Fred Talk). This week we learnt that two letters together that make one sound is called a 'special friend' (digraph).
- In maths we learnt about 1 more and 1 less.
- In PE we completed our topic on ball skills
- In Funky Fingers we continued to practise our fine motor skills by making pumpkins out
  of playdough, cutting around leaves, colouring Autumnal pictures, practising our letter
  formation and using tweezers to carefully pick up pom poms and place them onto
  shapes.
- This week we became artists. We used oil pastels to draw real life vegetables. We were so creative.
