





Below are some of the things we have learnt this week. Your child might like to tell you a little more about a few of these:

Continued with our RE topic 'Creation and Covenant' and painted pictures of where we see God's love.

In Maths we were counting forwards (counting on from any number), backwards and finding 1 more and 1 less than a number.

In English we began to learn about sentences. We ordered a group of words to make sure they made sense. We then had a go at writing them too.

Continued handwriting practice (numbers 4, 5, 6, 7) including correct number formation and position on the line - see guidance below to help you support your child at home.

In Science we began to learn about our senses and the body parts associated with those senses.

In Art we began to learn about how to draw self-portraits, using our mark-making skills from our last lesson.

In History we talked about special events from our past and how we can celebrate and remember them.

We began our Computing lessons, learning about different 'technology' around us and having a go at using a computer keyboard.

## <u>Homework</u>

Regular reading of the Read Write Inc. books (RWI) and library book.

Maths - please continue to practise counting forwards and backwards (up to 10). Try starting from different numbers (encouraging your child to not have to start at 0 again). Handwriting - Red handwriting books. Please practise 4, 5 6 and 7.
