















Line

A line is the path left by a moving point, e.g. a pencil or a
brush dipped in paint.

A line can take many forms, e.g. horizontal, diagonal,

A line can be used to show contours, movement, feeling or expression.

# Formal Elements:





### Shape and Form

A shape is an area enclosed by a line. It could be just an outline or it could be shaded in.

Form is a three-dimensional shape like a cube, a cone or a sphere.

Sculpture and 3D design are about creating shape and form.
