



Our Week



We have had a lovely and fun packed week. Here are some of the things that we have been learning, your child might like to tell you a little bit more about them:

- We continued our topic on "Exploring maps" by creating our own towns with junk modelling.
- In Literacy we read "Someone swallowed Stanley" and discussed how we need to save our oceans by not polluting them. We made posters to keep our oceans clean.
- We retold the story of "Someone swallowed Stanley" using pictures and we thought about how poor Stanley felt. We wrote speech bubbles.
- In RE we learnt about how Lent is a time to grow in love for others. We learnt about how Jesus entered Jerusalem on a Donkey. We shared a letter written to the class from this little donkey telling them about the special day that he carried a King.
- In RSE we talked about Life Online, Freddy Teddy learns to use a new device, serving as an introduction for children to the internet and how we use it. This draws on both positives and negatives of internet use, moving into children learning some basic rules to help them stay safe online.
- We practised our fine motor skills by completing lots of topic related creative and funky fingers activities.
- In PE - we continued practising our ball skills. We learnt the words "Dribbling, Keeping control, attacker, defender, opponent and space"
- In Maths we practised adding two numbers to make 10 (Number Bonds).
- In RSE we learnt what the word 'healthy' means and talked about how some foods are healthier than others.
