## Reading in Key Stage 1

## Handy Hints

- Make reading part of your daily routine
- Short sessions 10 mins a day is ideal
- Always make reading fun not a chore
- Talk and discuss the story
- Read a range of books not just the ones from school
- You can use the pictures to help read the text

Please remember to write the date and title of the book in the Reading Record. You can also add a comment if you wish.

**Read Write Inc.** - Children will be reading each day in their RWI lessons. Children will then bring home reading books every 3 days. Others will have the opportunity to change their books each day.

**Children's voice** – we would love to see what your child thinks about their books. After finishing a book, please encourage them to write a sentence about their book.



VIPERS is an acronym to aid the recall of the 6 reading skills. These are the areas children need to know and understand to improve their comprehension of texts.

Here are some example questions to use.

Why</li> <li>Tell me three facts you have learnt from the text.</li> <li>Find the part where</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Sequencing Questions</li> <li>What happens in the beginning of the story?</li> <li>How/where does the story start?</li> <li>What happened at the end of the?</li> <li>Can you retell the story to me in 20 words or less?</li> <li>What happened before that?</li> </ul>
